



Kent Swimming Championships 2026



Information for Trophy Winners

Congratulations on winning your Trophy! This is a huge achievement, and you should be very proud of what you have achieved. Please enjoy showing it off and celebrating your success for the rest of the year.

We often get questions around what to do with your trophy, and the information below should cover them all.

Engraving: There are two ways you can do this:

1. Return your trophy to the named Trophy Officer by the deadline and the engraving will be arranged before the next championships.
2. You can get the trophy engraved yourself and submit a receipt/invoice along with your personal and bank details to the Trophy Officer for reimbursement.

Returning Trophies: So that we can ensure the trophies are returned and ready for the next championships please follow the returns protocol below:

1. Ensure your trophy is returned to the named Trophy Officer by 10 January 2027.
2. The current Trophy Officer is Claire Cooley (RTW Monson SC) and can be contacted by email (claire.cooley@kentswimming.org)
3. Both you and your designated swimming club at the time of winning the trophy are responsible for its safe return.
4. If you leave for university or change clubs, please agree arrangements with your existing club or directly with the Trophy Officer for the return of your trophy before you leave.
5. If a trophy is not returned by the deadline, it may not be possible for the trophy to be engraved with your name before it is needed for the next championship winner.
6. Failure to return the trophy or if a trophy is lost or damaged, the costs involved in replacing the trophy will be passed on to you and your swimming club. Also, it might then not have the history associated with the trophy, so please take care of it and ensure it is returned so we can keep this legacy going.
7. If you would prefer not to accept the trophy and have the responsibility for it for the coming year, you do not have to accept it and it can remain in the care of Kent Swimming.
